RBA Performance Measures for the BSF Activities

Refresher to the “Data Dashboard” conversation I started.



- Currently there is a BSF Survey that was co-designed with the BSF Workgroup.
- In a series of emails, Chrysta raised the question of how the BSF Grantee and the BSF Workgroup are going to assess the BSF Strategy that SPIRITT is implementing. We have 3 methods right now:
 - *The Quarterly Progress Report*
 - *Evaluations facilitated at the Parent Engagement Workshops,*
 - *And soon the BSF Survey (where/when appropriate.)*
- Chrysta elevated that while data *might* be captured in these tools, there isn't one place, like a data dashboard, where people can, *at-a-glance*, assess how the strategies and activities are performing.
- The need: The BSF Workgroup would be challenged, if asked, to list all of the BSF activities. Additionally, they would be unable to share any data for the RBA measures for each BSF Activities.

When it comes to the BSF Activities... **How Did We Do?**

Remember, there are 3 ways we will assess the performance of the BSF Strategies and Activities using the Results Based Accountability (RBA) Model:




- **How Much Did We DO:** *Sample Reflection/Evaluation Questions*
 - How many meetings, trainings, and workshops did we have?
 - How many people did we train? How many people came to our meetings?
- **How Well Did We Do It:** *Sample Reflection/Evaluation Questions*
 - We had a plan for how we would implement trainings, workshops, and events.
 - Did those plans go as we imagined, or did other things happen?
 - What did participants tell us about their satisfaction with their BSF experience?
- **Is Anyone Better Off?** *Sample Reflection/Evaluation Questions*
 - Is anyone a stronger parent or leader because they participated in the BSF Activities?
 - Is anyone behaving in a new and improved way because they got involved in the BSF Activities?
 - Are organizations working with parents as partners now because of what we did?

 <p>#3: Is Anyone Better Now Because They Participated in the BSF Activities?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> These measures will help us learn if (and how) the BSF Activities helped participants.
