

State Leadership Teams

- Of 23 states responding to the 2020 survey, 13 report having an active state leadership team.
- Among states that have an active leadership team, median team size is 11 individuals representing 10 organizations.
- The most common sectors represented on leadership teams are child abuse and neglect prevention, family support programs and providers, Children's Trust Funds, child welfare, and early care and education system representatives and providers.
- Nearly half of states with Strengthening Families leadership teams include parent leaders on the team.
- Eleven states had a designated Strengthening Families coordinator in 2020, including 2 with full-time coordinators, and 9 in positions that also include other responsibilities.
